TROPICAL STORM WARNING DISCONTINUED FOR TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, GRENADA AND ITS DEPENDENCIES

Issued by the Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service

The Government of Trinidad and Tobago has lifted the Tropical Storm Warning for Trinidad and Tobago as of 5:00 a.m. today.

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service has lifted the Tropical Storm Warning for Grenada and its Dependencies as of 5:00 am today.

At 5:00 am, Tuesday June 20, 2017, the centre of Tropical Storm Bret was located near 10.6°N latitude 62.91°W longitude or approximately 160 km to the west of Trinidad and no longer poses a threat to the islands of interest. However, localized rainfall can still be expected today with rain and/ or showers and possible thundershowers.

This is the final advisory that the Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service will issue on Tropical Storm Bret but we will continue to monitor this system as it moves further west away from the Southern Windward Islands.
