TROPICAL STORM BRET ADVISORY #3

TROPICAL STORM CONDITIONS OVER TRINIDAD AND PARTS OF TOBAGO

Issued by the Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service

Tropical Storm Warning remains in effect for Trinidad and Tobago, Grenada and its Dependencies.

This Tropical Storm Warning means that Trinidad and Tobago in this case, can continue to experience Tropical Storm conditions over the next 6 hours, and Grenada and its Dependencies can expect Tropical Storm conditions within 6 hours.

At 11:00 pm, Monday June 19, 2017, the centre of Tropical Storm Bret was located near 10.0°N latitude 61.3°W longitude near the southern coast of Trinidad.

Tropical Storm Bret is moving to the west-northwest at about 37 km/hr and is expected to gradually slow down over the next 48 hours. On the forecast track, Bret is expected to begin moving away from Trinidad and toward the northeast coast of Venezuela early Tuesday.

Maximum sustained winds are near 65 km/hr with higher gusts. Little change in strength is forecast during the next 12 to 24 hours. Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 130 km from the centre. Minimum central pressure is 1008mb.

Citizens and all concerned are advised to closely follow the directions and advice of their Disaster Emergency Managers at this time. Adopt all necessary measures to preserve life and property.

Repeating the position of Bret at 11:00 pm is 10.0°N latitude 61.3°W longitude, near the southern coast of Trinidad.

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service will issue another bulletin at 3:00am, Tuesday 20th June, 2017.
