#### **TROPICAL STORM KIRK HAS MOVED INTO THE EASTERN CARIBBEAN SEA**

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service continues to monitor the weather associated with TS Kirk which is currently affecting the islands of the Lesser Antilles.

Status at 5:00 am today:

Tropical Storm Kirk was located near 13.2N 62.5W or about 175km West-Wouthwest of St. Lucia and moving West at 19 km/h with maximum sustained winds of 85km/hr. Kirk is expected to weaken as it moves further into the Caribbean Sea.

Summary of watches and warnings still in effect as at 5 a.m.:

A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for...

- Barbados
- St. Lucia
- Dominica
- Martinique
- Guadeloupe

A Tropical Storm Watch is in effect for...

- St. Vincent and the Grenadines

These watches and warnings will likely be gradually discontinued later today.
